Dr. Sharon Johnston

Associate Professor with the Department of Family Medicine at the University of Ottawa

Dr Johnston is a family physician and Associate Professor in the Department of Family Medicine, University of Ottawa, and a Clinician Investigator at the Bruyere Research Institute.

Her research focuses on health services delivery in primary care, particularly performance measurement and reporting to the public and providers. Dr. Johnston is a Co-Principal Investigator for the CIHR-funded pan-Canadian Transformation Study which seeks to improve the science and methods for practice-based primary care performance measurement and reporting. For the past two decades she has also been researching and teaching about medical professionalism and the changing social contract between physicians and the society they serve.
